




#### Course Structure

#### 54 hours of teaching time

- 36 hours of lectures (12 x 3-hour lectures)
- 18 hours of seminars (12 x 1.5-hour seminars)



Lectures will take place in the morning or afternoon typically between:

- Morning lectures: 09:00 13:00 BST
- Afternoon lectures: 14:00 18:00 BST
- Seminar classes last 1.5 hours and run at different points in the day
- 2-3 hours per day in self-guided study





#### Assessment

- Ongoing feedback from the class teacher
- Exams, essays or group projects, including:
  - Midsession assessment in week 2
  - Final assessment (end of week 3)



- LSE Summer School transcript and certificate awarded to participants
- Assessment is optional (essential for credit)

- Degree-level study in English
- IELTS 7.0 (all areas), TOEFL 107 (all areas)
- CET 470+ with Preparatory English course



N.B.: You must apply for a Summer School course by March 2025 TBC to be eligible to apply for this scholarship.




#### Why stay with LSE?

- Bookings can be made once you've received an offer








