English Language Requirements



Standard Requirements

To be granted admission into the Study Abroad and Exchange program, applicants are required meet the English Language Proficiency requirements for their relevant level of study. Minimum entry requirements are listed in Schedule 4 of the <u>ACU Handbook</u>.

Any qualifications or tests submitted as proof of English language proficiency must have been achieved **no more than two years** prior to the program commencement date.

This applies only to undergraduate students. The recommended scores have been determined in consultation with the ACU Centre for Languages.

Alternative Requirements for Undergraduate Entry

Completion of English studies at High School in Denmark, Finland, Germany, the Netherlands, Sweden and Norway with an acceptable grade:

- 1-year full-time study in English completed at university or high-school level equivalent to 60 ECTS.
- CEFR Common European Framework of Reference for Languages statement of English language proficiency at a minimum level of B2

 ACU proforma to be completed by the applicant's home university.
- International Baccalaureate (IB): English A: literature or English A: language or literature at higher or standard level

Note:

- 1. Students undertaking units within Law, Health Sciences and Teacher Education courses may be required to have a higher level of English proficiency as noted in Schedule 4 of the ACU Handbook.
- 2. Unit prerequisites may still apply and require course coordinator's approval.
