BASIC COUNT	<p>All the marks of the exams are added together multiplied by the number of ECTS of each exam (<i>30 cum laude</i> is counted as 32).</p> <p>Any supernumerary or free-choice exam is excluded from the count.</p> <p>The sum is divided by the total weight in ECTS of the teachings considered (average out of 30).</p> <p>The average out of 30 thus obtained is converted into a grade out of 110 by multiplying the value obtained by 11 and dividing it by 3.</p>
FINAL EXAMINATION SCORE	<p>from 0 to 9 points with an indication to use 9 points only for outstanding work (in cooperation with leading data science companies in the economic/financial sectors)</p>
