Master's Degree Program (Laurea Magistrale) in Global Business and Management

Program

Università Cattolica, through the Faculty of Business and Law (Master's Degree Program (Laurea Magistrale) in Global Business Management) offers its students the possibility of obtaining at the conclusion of their study path a double qualification of Laurea Magistrale from Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore and MBA in International Business from the California State University San Marcos.

The program covers two years of study, with the first year and the first semester of the second year undertaken at Università Cattolica and the last period at the California State University San Marcos.

Eligible students and how to apply

Students enrolled in the first year of Laurea Magistrale at the Faculty of Business and Law - Laurea Magistrale in Global Business Management can apply for the program. They should have an average mark of at least 24/30 (3.0 GPA).

Applications must be submitted via the appropriate <u>call for competition</u> by March 31, 2022 with payment of the relative <u>application fee.</u>

Applications will be assessed and a ranking will be compiled, based on the following:

- 60% weighted average of results of exams passed and registered by March 31, 2022
- 40% total credits accumulated by March 31, 2022

Requirements before departure:

Students have to pass all the exams of the first year of Global Business Management by the end of September 2022.

Language requirements



To be selected, students should have one of the following certificates:

- TOEFL/IBT (score of at least 85);
- IELTS (overall score min. 6.5 with a writing section of min. 6 and all other sections of min. 5.5).

Certificates must be obtained not before September 2020 and with results obtained by March 31, 2022.

Program requirements

To obtain the MBA in International Business at California State University San Marcos, students must complete the program of exams set out in the agreement.

Theology

Please note that all students taking part in the Degree program are required, in accordance with Cattolica regulations, to take the Theology exams present in their course plan.

Thesis

The final thesis of Laurea Magistrale must be written in English. A summary, written in the language of the student's Home University must be attached. The final thesis will be evaluated by a supervisor at the Home University, according to the institution policy, with a possible collaboration of a cosupervisor at the Host University.

Students will have to follow the Cattolica procedure to register for a Cattolica official Graduation day (i.e. in terms of steps, deadlines and fees).

Costs and scholarship



The following tuition fee can be subject to change as it is referred to the current academic year.

Application fee: € 35 Tuition fee: € 15.500

Scholarships: 2 scholarships of € 4.000

Please note that the Cattolica scholarship will be paid in form of reimbursement, the beneficiaries will receive direct instructions regarding the procedure to follow.

Students selected for the program will be responsible for the costs of their stay abroad (travel, accommodation, food and costs of material).

Students selected for the program must also be officially enrolled at Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore while they are abroad (keeping to deadlines for university fees, study plans, request for graduation etc).

Student Safety Package



All students participating in an official Cattolica International program must accept the "Student Safety Package" provisions by downloading the "Safety Check Students" app for the geolocation and instant messaging features to be used exclusively in the event of an emergency. The "Student Safety Package" also includes health insurance coverage for the entire duration of the program.
