# Study Abroad

- Nominated students will be sent the online application link directly by the respective incoming coordinator.
- Further information and the application link for our different campuses can be found on our website.

## Application Deadlines:

- For fall (beginning end of August or October 1<sup>st</sup>): **July 1<sup>st</sup>**
- For winter (beginning January or February): **November 1<sup>st</sup>**
- For spring (beginning April 1<sup>st</sup>): **February 1<sup>st</sup>**

## Language Proficiency:

- Language of instruction: English and German (not all courses are available in English)
- Language requirements: Advanced English or German (minimum B2 level)
