## Written exam

Paper-based written test corresponding to the upper-intermediate/advanced level:
Text Analysis (Missing text) - 8 pts
Gap Fill (sentences) - 6 pts
Text Analysis (Multiple choice) - 6 points
Listening (Cloze) - 10 points
Maximum score: 30/30

## Oral exam

The oral exam will be based on the course syllabus and the practical activities carried out in class. Students will prepare a presentation of no fewer than 12 minutes, with 3 minutes for Q+A. They will be graded on structure, content, body language, use of transition phrases, visual aids (the analysis of at least one graph or chart is required), and fielding questions.
Maximum score: 30/30

Please note: The final mark will be calculated on the average between the two parts of the exam. Students MUST pass the written part of the exam in order to do the oral part of the exam - minimum score 18/30.
