Boulevard Vauban, Lille

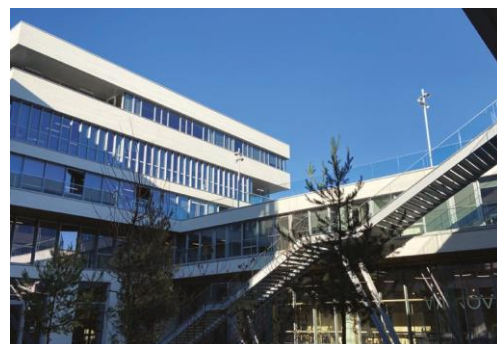
