APPLICATION

The application takes place online. Once a student has been nominated, they will receive information regarding the application process. Students must have completed their 1st year at their home university and must have a minimum B2 level of the target language (French or English) – certificate required.

Documents required* (in English for BCIE or French for BCIF):

- Application form
- Curriculum Vitae
- A passport/ID photo-scan
- Motivation letter letter of application indicating student's reasons for applying
- Transcript in English /Official copies from the home university
- Proof of the B2 level of English (or French for BCIF)
- Bachelor degree diploma (*for Master's level students only)
- Two academic or professional recommendation letters (for Master or DD level students only). Letters must be printed on letter head paper, signed and dated
