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2. General information

Academic entry requirements	<p>To apply for a study mobility within an exchange program, students must be nominated by their home university.</p> <p>Deadlines for nominations AND applications :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • June 1st for the Autumn Semester or the Full Academic Year ; • October 30th for the Spring Semester. <p>Each nomination must contain the full name, date of birth, email address of the students, the cycle in which the mobility shall take place (undergraduate, Postgraduate, PhD), the period of the stay and the relevant ISCED code (for Erasmus+ nominations only).</p>
Language requirements	<p>Our standard language requirement starts at B1 level in French.</p> <p>Please note that students wishing to enroll in courses taught in English are required to meet the level of English established for regular students (B2).</p>
Academic calendar	<p>The Academic Year at Université Évry Paris-Saclay is divided into two semesters:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First semester (Autumn semester) from September to January ; • Second semester (Spring semester) from January to June.

	<p>The starting date of the semesters varies from a study department to another. The information is sent to the students once accepted in the program.</p> <p>A prior date of arrival to the semester starting date is recommended to settle in, arrange the accommodation, meet their coordinators and finalize the course selection.</p>
Courses	<p>Exchange students must choose their courses in the field of study stated in the bilateral exchange agreement signed between home university and Université Évry Paris-Saclay.</p> <p>List of the courses available : https://www.univ-evry.fr/formation/loffre-de-formation.html</p> <p>/!\ It is not guaranteed that all modules shown for the previous year will be running or will be available in their current year of study.</p>
Academic Load	<p>Students are expected to take the normal academic load of 30 credits (ECTS) per semester.</p>
Examinations and assessments	<p>Students enrolled in any course are entitled to an ordinary assessment and a resit. The ordinary assessment normally includes a final exam in December/January for the first semester courses, a final exam in May/June for the second semester courses, and then a general resit in June.</p>
Tuition and other fees	<p>Exchange students are exempt from paying tuition fees at Université Évry Paris-Saclay. There are no additional administration fees for students to pay on arrival.</p>
Transcripts of records	<p>An academic transcript will normally be issued by the end of following February (for Autumn semester students) and by the end of the following July (for Spring semester and full-year students).</p> <p>Information about the grading system of Université d'Evry : https://www.univ-evry.fr/international/venir-etudier-a-luniversite-devry/preparer-son-arrivee/controle-de-connaissances.html</p>
Certificate of arrival and departure	<p>The Department of Research and International Relations is the signatory of any Arrival and Departure Certificate. The document is then given back to the student, who is responsible for its transmission to their home institution.</p>
