Entry Requirements	Applications will only be considered through the nomination submitted by the home institution.

Language Certificate (a proof of your level from your home institution) *: -Spanish B1 level required for courses taught in Spanish. -Spanish B2 level required for master courses and TRAINEESHIPS in Dentistry, Medicine, Nutrition, Physiotherapy & Podiatry. -English B1 level if you will follow courses taught in English. -English B2 level required for Business & Marine sciences students. 4. A Passport sized picture (for your student's card) 5. <u>Criminal Record Certificate -in Spanish, English or validated by your Home University-</u> (required for all the Traineeship's exchanges from Education degrees, Medicine, Nursing, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Psychology, Podiatry, Physiotherapy, Sports Sciences and for all the incoming in Dentistry-studies and traineeship's). 1 Personal Liability Insurance is personal insurance that covers possible damage caused by the student to a third person or objects.
