Please find below important information regarding the application procedures for 2025/26 Erasmus incoming students at the **Faculty of Medicine** of the University of Salamanca.

Please note that we will not answer any message requesting information that is already provided or available on our website. In any case, this office will only answer to specific administrative questions that cannot be resolved through any of the links provided here. Academic questions must be addressed to the International Academic Coordinator at the corresponding faculty, school or university centre.

\*\*ATTENTION - ROTATIONS: IN THE EVENT OF OVERCAPACITY AT THE SALAMANCA HOSPITAL, STUDENTS WILL BE ASSIGNED TO THE ZAMORA HOSPITAL FOR THEIR CLINICAL ROTATIONS. Zamora is a city located 50 minutes from Salamanca and has frequent bus services. The hospital in Zamora ias also part of the University of Salamanca campus.

1st STEP: ERASMUS REGISTRATION	
Registration deadline	July 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2025 for ALL STUDENTS (WINTER SEMESTER, SUMMER SEMESTER or FULL ACADEMIC YEAR). There is NO SECOND DEADLINE for 2 <sup>nd</sup> -semester applications.

	Students duly nominated by their home institution must complete the online Erasmus Application Form, print it as a pdf and send it by email to the International Office-Inbound Mobility (erasmus-in@usal.es), together with:  • a recent passport-size photograph  • a copy of the ID document or passport
	This document is a <b>MANDATORY REQUIREMENT</b> for the correct enrolment of Erasmus students at the University of Salamanca. Incomplete forms or lacking a photograph won't be considered.
Acceptance Letter	As of June 18 <sup>th</sup> , 2025, an Acceptance Letter will be sent by email (with a copy to the Erasmus responsible at their institution) to those students who have correctly sent the Application Form and the other required documents. Students must bring this Acceptance Letter to Salamanca and present it when enrolling in the corresponding Centre.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> STEP: OTHER DOCUMENTS

#### LEARNING AGREEMENT

The University of Salamanca is connected with the EWP network and accepts **Online Learning Agreements**. The OLA must be sent for approval and signature to the **International Coordinator for Medicine** in Salamanca.

# Health and Mobility Insurances

### **MANDATORY**

- HEALTH CARE: Students from the EU, EFTA and Switzerland are entitled to
  medical care in the medical centres and hospitals that form part of or have
  agreements with the Spanish National Health System (Seguridad Social). Students
  must apply for the European Health Card (EIHC) at the health service offices in
  their country of origin (GHIC for UK students). Foreign students from other
  countries than the above-mentioned or who are not covered by national health
  plans must have private health insurance.
- MOBILITY INSURANCE: The Mobility Insurance of the University of Salamanca is MANDATORY for all Erasmus students regardless of the requirements and/or regulations of the student's home institution on the matter. This insurance must be purchased by each student directly via the website:

### NO OTHER INSURANCE WILL BE ACCEPTED

Before arriving in Salamanca, students must send by email a copy of both documents (EHIC or equivalent insurance, and the ERGO insurance policy with the student's details) to this International Relations Service - Incoming Erasmus Mobility (erasmus-in@usal.es). This is a mandatory requirement to complete their registration at the University of Salamanca.

Language of instruction: SPANISH	The language of instruction at our institution, in which subjects are taught and exams are conducted, is <b>SPANISH</b> . Students must have an <b>sufficient Spanish skills</b> before their arrival to be able to <b>follow lectures and sit exams</b> . The <b>minimum reccomended level is B1</b> , although no certificate is required.

Students must pay fees for course materials and linguistic consulting.
