ATTACHMENT - INFORMATION NOTICE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

1. Introduction

Pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the “protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data” (hereinafter also “GDPR”), we are providing the information required on the processing of your personal data (“Data”) performed by Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore (hereinafter also the “University”).

2. Identity and contact details for the Data controller

The Controller of the processing of your Data is Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore, with registered office in Largo Agostino Gemelli 1, 20123 Milan, telephone (+39) 027234.1.

3. Categories of personal data

The Data processed by the University include:

- Personal Data and contact details.
- Special categories of personal Data pursuant to Art. 9 of the GDPR (e.g. Data on the health status and, more specifically, data relative to the individual’s body temperature).

4. Processing purpose and legal basis

Data provided by you will be processed for the following purposes: prevention from contagion of COVID-19.

The legal basis of the processing is the necessity to comply with a legal obligation to which the Data Controller is subject, namely the implementation of anti-contagion security protocols pursuant to Article 1, no. 7, paragraph d) of the Prime Ministerial Decree dated 11 March 11 2020, as indicated in the "Shared protocol on measures to combat and contain the spread of the Covid-19 virus in the workplace" signed on 14 March 2020, plus, subsequent amendments and additions.

5. Processing methods

Personal Data are processed manually, digitally and electronically applying logics strictly connected to the purposes and, in any case, to guarantee the security and confidentiality of the Data pursuant to laws in force. The Data processed for the aforementioned purposes will be accessible only to those persons explicitly delegated and adequately instructed by the Data controller.

6. Data storage period

The Data controller may retain the personal data acquired until the termination of the state of emergency. Subsequently, for the maximum time stipulated by the relevant legal provisions regarding the restriction of rights and/or the expiry of the action and, in general, for the implementation/defence of the rights of the Data Controller in disputes brought by public authorities, subjects/public bodies and private entities and, in any case, for the entire duration of the trial at all phases and levels.

7. Subject categories that the Data can be communicated to

Your Data can be communicated to:

- Public and private Bodies or competent Authorities, to comply with legal obligations.

Subjects belonging to the categories that data can be communicated to, will process the Data, based on the case, as Processors specifically appointed by the Controller pursuant to law, or as autonomous Controllers.

The list of Data Processors appointed is updated continuously and available from the University offices.

8. Transfer of personal Data to countries extra EU

Personal Data cannot be transferred to non-EU Countries.

9. Data Protection Officer, D.P.O.

The University has appointed a Data Protection Officer, D.P.O., who interested parties can contact for questions relating to the processing of their personal data and the restriction of their rights, by contacting them at: dpo@unicatt.it

10. Rights of the Data subject

As Data subject you have the right to:

- Ask the Controller to access, cancel, rectify if inaccurate, integrated if incomplete your data, and to restrict processing in cases set forth in Art. 18 of the GDPR;
- Oppose, at any time, in whole or in part, to the processing of the Data necessary for the pursuit of the legitimate interest of the Controller;
- If the conditions for the portability right pursuant to Art. 20 of the GDPR exist, receive in a structured form, commonly used and readable with an automatic device the Data supplied to the Controller and, if technically feasible, transmit it to another Controller without hindrance;
- Revoke consent given at any time;
- Lodge a complaint with a supervisory Authority.
