OFA- Preliminary Test Scheme

The final OFA examination (VF OFA) and the Preliminary Test, although structured in the same way (12 mathematical questions) and administered in the computer room from the PROVA MATEMATICA platform on the same dates, have substantial differences:

- A. If you are a student who has been assigned additional training obligations (OFAs) to make up for your educational debt you must take the VF OFA (see slide 1):
- You must register for VF OFA through ICATT.
- The VF OFA is necessary to access the General Mathematics and Political Economy (Microeconomics) exams.
- If you do not pass a VF OFA within the year of enrolment, you will be enrolled as a repeat student and will not be able to access the second year.

B. If you are a student who falls into the following categories: transferred from another degree programme or university, enrolled before the a.y. 2020-21, with OFAs completed for your career, read slide 2 to find out whether you have to take the Preliminary Test. If so, please note that:

- The preliminary test is necessary to access the General Mathematics and Political Economy (Microeconomics) exams.
- You must register for the Preliminary Test from the Blackboard course 'Preparation for the Preliminary Test' according to the indicated procedures.

The flowcharts on the next two slides illustrate the different procedures in detail.
