(March or September) If you are travelling to Cologne before the start of the semester, we recommend to take out a travel health insurance.

It is valid throughout Germany on local public

Semester	You need a proof of health insurance coverage
(October or April)	from a German statutory health insurer or an exemption certificate from a German statutory health insurer for your enrolment. A German statutory health insurance costs approx. 130 EUR per month.
/isa Requirements	It is your responsibility to familiarise yourself with the visa conditions for entry to Germany before you arrive. You must apply for a residence permit within 90 days of your arrival.
Semester Fee	The UoC does not charge any tuition ees. However, all students must pay a social contribution fee of around 320 EUR per semester. This fee also includes the "Deutschlandsemesterticket" – it is a personalised digital ticket for one semester.
