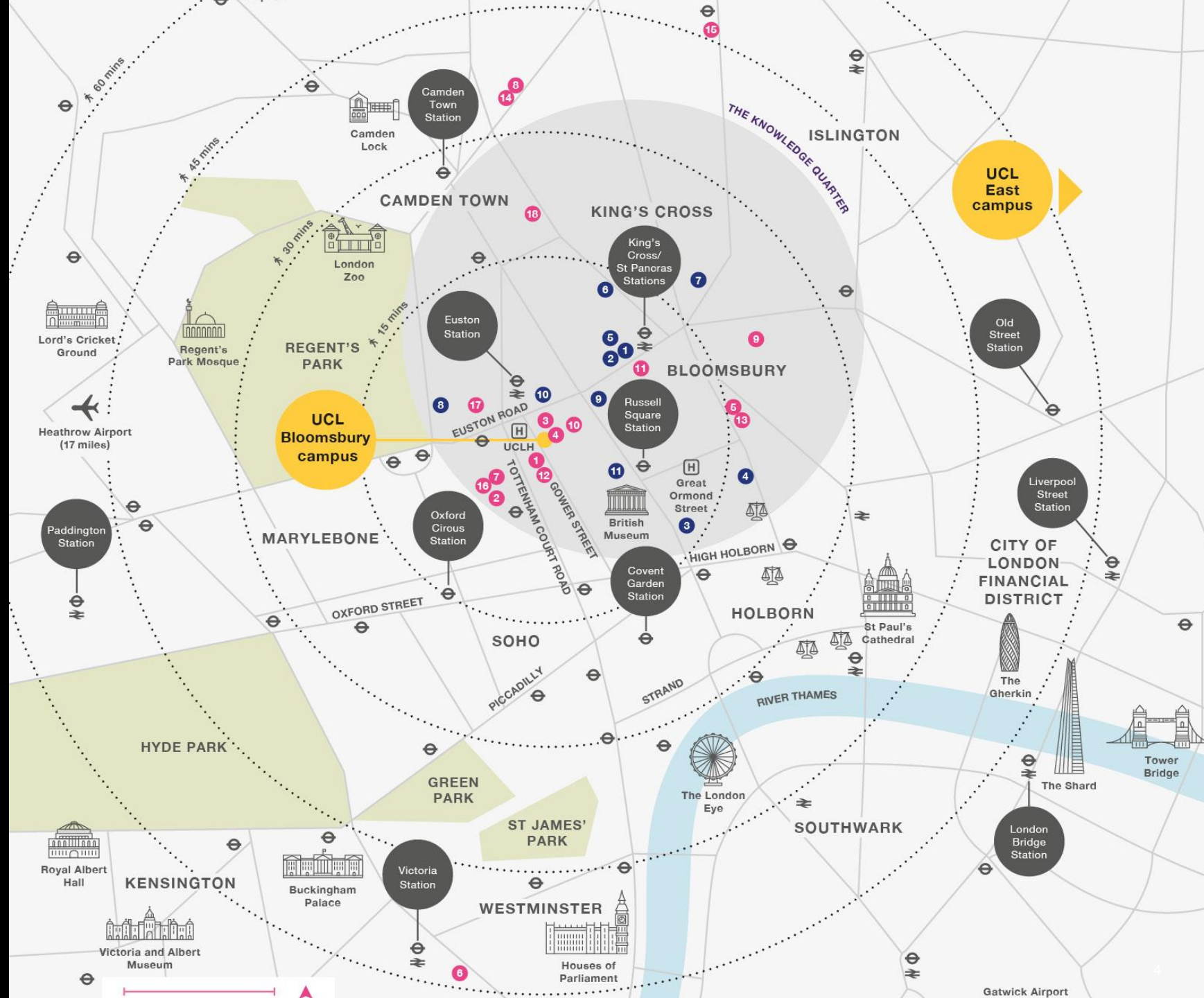

# Studying at UCL



- One module per session
