

## CALL FOR SELECTION OF GROUP TUTORS - A.Y. 2025-2026

Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore invites students and graduates of the **Faculty of SCIENZE BANCARIE, FINANZIARIE E ASSICURATIVE** to apply to carry out **activities of Group Tutoring** for students of the same Faculty **for the degree course in Business and Finance started in Brescia's Campus.**

### Requirements

- A. maximum age limit: 30 years.
- B. integrated degree programme qualification in Scienze bancarie, finanziarie e assicurative from Università Cattolica at the headquarters in Milan;
- C. master's degree obtained, or enrollment in a master's degree in Scienze bancarie, finanziarie e assicurative form Università Cattolica at the headquarters in Milan.
- D. knowledge of Italian language

### Duration of the assignment

1<sup>st</sup> of September 2025 – 31<sup>st</sup> of August 2026

### Commitment

Up to a maximum of 350 hours; the number of hours may vary depending on the number of students assigned.

### Typology of activity

Welcoming incoming new students for undergraduate, graduate and integrated degree programmes; accompanying them during their university career (planning examinations, organising study, identifying an effective study method), intercepting students in difficulty and planning remedial activities with undergraduate students; cooperation in orientation initiatives.

The activities must be guaranteed according to the indications provided by the tutoring office, in relation to the specific needs of individual degree programmes.

### Training

Group Tutors must compulsorily participate in the initial training activity scheduled starting from the 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2025. The training will be delivered exclusively in Italian.

### Remuneration

21 Euro/hour gross of withholding taxes.

### Forms and submission application

### Selection

A selection committee, appointed by the Faculty Council, will analyse the applications received and make an initial selection with the aim of ensuring that the candidates are representative of the various degree programmes and in the light of the following criteria:

- *curriculum studiorum* (qualification obtained, grade, study plan, profile if applicable, possible enrolment in PhD programme);
- *curriculum vitae*.

Only pre-selected candidates will undergo an aptitude and motivational interview, to be held by the first week of July 2025.

The final ranking will be drawn up on the basis of the following points:

- up to a maximum of 40 points out of 100 for CV and CS
- up to a maximum of 60 points out of 100 for the interview

The list of successful candidates and the assignment of tasks will be communicated by e-mail. The minutes of the selection will be available in the Tutoring office.

In the event of inability or failure to perform the required tasks, the Group Tutor will be declared disqualified.
