- Online only students: No visa needed and no minimum enrollment requirements if you study from outside the U.S.
- All international students: Meet the English Proficiency Requirement or enroll in ESL only courses. Some of the exams we accept include:

Berkeley Haas Global Access Program Admission Requirements

- Minimum **2 years** of undergraduate coursework
- Minimum GPA: **3.0**
- Essay (statement of purpose)
- Proof of English Language Proficiency*:
 - TOEFL: 90
 - IELTS: 7.0
 - Duolingo: 125
 - TEM-4 or TEM-8: 70
 - DAAD: C1
 - Cambridge C1 Advanced
 - CEFR: C1

*Students without a test score may request an English language Proficiency Assessment with Berkeley Global
