2025-26 Academic Calendar

- 2025 Summer Sessions: June 23 August 1; August 4 September 12
 - Applications due March 25, 2025
- 2025 Fall Quarter: September 24 December 12
 - Applications due May 1, 2025
- Winter Quarter 2026: January 5 March 20
 - Applications due October 1, 2025
- Spring Quarter 2026: March 30 June 11
 - Applications due January 5, 2026



How much does it cost?

- Tuition and Student Fees: \$8,600 per quarter
- Living expenses (estimated)
 - Housing \$1,000-1,400 per month
 - Meals/Food \$450 per month
 - Other Academic Expenses (textbooks, software, etc) \$200-500 per quarter
 - Extra Campus Activities (sports teams, club membership, etc) \$50-150 per quarter
 - Travel varies by students GSP staff and student assistants can help guide you to discounted trips and activities!
- Estimated total for one academic quarter \$14,750 17,000
