# Important Steps After Acceptance

- Apply for on-campus housing (required for new exchange students)
- Take placement exams in mathematics and English (required to pre-enroll new freshmen in classes)
- Submit the UWL Affidavit of Support and bank statements so we can issue the I-20 immigration document
- Apply for the F-1 student visa and pay the I-901 SEVIS fee
- Attend the virtual "Visa Preparation and Pre-Departure Planning" session hosted by UW-La Crosse
- Submit the "Arrival Form" after they have received their visa and made their travel arrangements
