



CALL FOR SELECTION OF GROUP TUTORS - A.Y. 2026/27

Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore invites students and graduates of the Faculty of Psychology to apply for Group Tutoring activities for students enrolled in the same Faculty, bachelor's degree in ***psychology***.

Requirements

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- A. Bachelor's degree obtained at Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore, Milan campus – a degree obtained in the Bachelor's program in *Psychology* will be preferential;
- B. Master's degree obtained at Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore in the Faculty of Psychology, Milan campus;
- C. Age not exceeding 30 years;
- D. Excellent knowledge of both English and Italian.

The post-graduate internship required for admission to the State Examination for professional qualification as a psychologist will also be considered a preferential qualification.

Duration of the assignment

1 September 2026 – 31 August 2027

Work commitment

Up to a maximum of 350 hours; the total number of hours may vary depending on the number of assigned students.

Activities

Welcoming first-year students enrolled in Bachelor's, Master's, and Single-Cycle Master's degree programs, and supporting them throughout their university journey (exam planning, study organization, identification of an effective study method), identifying students experiencing difficulties, planning remedial activities, and collaborating in orientation initiatives.

The activities must be carried out according to the guidelines provided by the Tutoring Office, in relation to the specific needs of the individual degree programs.

Training

Group Tutors are required to participate in the initial training activities starting from 1 September 2026.

Remuneration

€21 per hour before statutory tax deductions.

Selection process

A Selection Committee appointed by the Faculty Council will review all applications and carry out an initial screening, with the aim of ensuring representation across the various degree programmes, based on the following criteria:

- academic record (degree obtained, final grade, study plan, academic profile, and possible enrolment in a PhD);
- curriculum vitae.

Only shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend an aptitude and motivational interview, to be held by the end of **June 2026**.

The final ranking will be based on the following criteria:

- up to **40 points out of 100** for academic record and CV;
- up to **60 points out of 100** for the interview (in English).

The list of selected candidates and the assignment of duties will be communicated by email.

The official minutes of the selection process will be available at the Tutoring Office.

In the event of inability or failure to perform the assigned tasks, the Group Tutor may be declared ineligible.
