





Language level requirements	TUL does not require the official English certificates. However, the expected level, permitting students to follow classes in English, is B1+/B2.
English language course	Students can also take part in different English courses (on B1+, B2 and C1/C2 levels) during the semester.
Accommodation	TUL provides students with places in our dormitories located around the campus. Students choose whether they are interested in the accommodation during their online application. The price of a double room is around 120 EUR/month, with obligatory deposit of 1000 PLN (200-220 EUR)
Erasmus Student Network	TUL is strongly supported by the local ESN section, <u>ESN-EYE</u> , which is responsible e.g. for <u>mentor system</u> .
