

SELDa computer-based English exam (A2) - 75 minutes

Format: 4 parts

1. Listening
2. Reading
3. Use of English
4. Writing

Listening: 2 parts 10 questions – 10 points

- Part 1: 1 longer passage with true/false exercise
- Part 2: 1 longer passage with multiple choice exercise

Reading: 3 parts: 12 questions – 12 points

- Part 1: short texts with multiple choice questions (notices and messages)
- Part 2: longer passage with multiple choice questions
- Part 3: longer passage with true/false questions

Use of English: 2 parts: 18 questions

- Part 1: cloze test (10 gaps)
- Part 2: open cloze exercise (8 gaps)

Writing: one e-mail to write (80-100 words) - 10 points

Total Listening, Reading and Use of English: 50 questions – 50 points

Pass mark: 30/50 – 60%

Oral part

in pairs, approx. 12 minutes per pair

- three parts

Part 1: Introduction and personal information: 1) Candidates introduce themselves 2) Candidates are asked to spell their name/surname 3) Candidates are asked to read some numbers 4) Candidates answer some questions on their personal life

Part 2: Describe a picture provided by the lecturer.

Part 3: Provide a definition of some words present in the textbook.
