

CALL FOR “GROUP TUTOR” SELECTION - A.Y. 2026-2027

Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore invites students and graduates of the **Faculty of AGRICULTURAL, FOOD AND ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES** to apply to carry out Group Tutoring activities for students of the same Faculty at Piacenza campus.

Requirements

- A. Bachelor's degree, to be attained by December 2026, with the intention of enrolling in a master's degree program of the same Faculty at Piacenza campus; students who fall into this category are asked to produce a PDF self-certification indicating:
 - a) the expected graduation session (July, October, December);
 - b) number of ECTS earned by the date of submission of the application, except for any ECTS already obtained in the summer session of the current year;
 - c) weighted average of the exams taken by the date of submission of the application;
 - d) master's degree course in which they plan to enroll;
- B. Bachelor's degree from the Faculty of Agricultural, Food and Environmental Sciences of Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore, Piacenza campus, and enrollment in a master's degree of the same faculty and campus;
- C. Master's degree with a bachelor's degree from Università Cattolica, Piacenza campus;
- D. maximum age limit: 30 years;
- E. for the tutoring of Food Production Management Degree Course only, English language proficiency resulting from possession of one of the following international certifications at CEFR level B2:
 - a) Academic IELTS, score of at least 6;
 - b) TOEFL / IBT, score of at least 65;
 - c) Cambridge Certifications;
 - d) First Certificate and above.

Duration of assignment

September 1, 2026 - August 31, 2027.

Commitment

Up to a maximum of 350 hours; the number of hours may vary depending on the number of students assigned.

Nature of activity

Welcoming incoming new students from undergraduate, graduate and integrated degree programs and coaching students during their university career (planning exams, organizing study, identifying an effective study method), intercepting students in difficulty and planning catch-up activities with undergraduate students; cooperating in orientation initiatives.

The activities shall be guaranteed pursuant to the guidelines provided by the Tutoring Office, in accordance with the specific needs of single degree courses.

Training

Group Tutors must compulsorily attend the initial training activity scheduled from September 1st, 2026.

Remuneration

21 euros/hour gross of withholdings taxes.

Forms and submission of application

From May 5th to June 5th, 2026, the documents, which can be found at www.unicatt.it/tutorato-pc, should be sent in pdf to the Tutoring Office at tutordigruppo-pc@unicatt.it.

Selection

A selection committee, appointed by the Faculty Council, will analyse the applications received and make an initial selection with the aim of ensuring that the candidates are representative of the various degree programmes and in the light of the following criteria:

- curriculum studiorum (qualification obtained, grade, study plan, profile if applicable, possible enrolment in PhD Programme);
- curriculum vitae.

Only pre-selected candidates will undergo an aptitude and motivational interview, to be held by the end of July 2026.

The final ranking will be drawn up on the basis of the following points:

- up to a maximum of 40 points out of 100 for CV and CS
- up to a maximum of 60 points out of 100 for the interview

The list of successful candidates and the assignment of tasks will be communicated by e-mail. The minutes of the selection will be available in the Tutoring office.

In the event of inability or failure to **perform** the required tasks, the Group Tutor will be declared disqualified.
