



CALL FOR SELECTION OF GROUP TUTORS - A.Y. 2026-2027

Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore invites students and graduates of the **Faculty of MEDICINE AND SURGERY** to apply to carry out **activities of Group Tutoring** for students of the same Faculty.

- no. 1 for degree programmes in Dentistry and Dental hygiene
- no. 1 for the degree programme in Physiotherapy
- no. 1 for the degree programme in Nursing

Requirements

For all degree programmes:

- A.** maximum age limit: 30 years.

For degree programmes in Pharmacy and Cosmetic science and technology:

- A.** integrated degree programme qualification in Pharmacy;
- B.** enrolment in the fourth or fifth year of the integrated degree programme in Pharmacy;
- C.** applications from graduates from other universities in the chemical-pharmaceutical field will also be evaluated.

For the degree programmes in Medicine and Surgery (Italian):

- A.** integrated degree programme qualification in Medicine and Surgery from Università Cattolica;
- B.** enrolment in the fourth, fifth or sixth year of the integrated degree programme in Medicine and Surgery.

For the degree programme in Medicine and surgery (English) – Rome Campus:

- A.** integrated degree programme qualification in Medicine and surgery obtained at Università Cattolica;
- B.** enrolment in the fourth, fifth or sixth year of the integrated degree programme in Medicine and surgery;
- C.** good knowledge of the Italian language.

For the degree programme in Medicine and Technological Medicine and Surgery:

- A.** integrated degree programme qualification in Medicine and Surgery from Università Cattolica;
- B.** enrolment in the second year of the integrated degree programme in Medicine and Technological Medicine and Surgery;
- C.** enrolment in the fourth, fifth or sixth year of the integrated degree programme in Medicine and surgery.

For degree programmes in Dentistry and Dental hygiene:

- A.** integrated degree programme qualification in Dentistry from Università Cattolica;
- B.** enrolment in the fourth, fifth or sixth year of the integrated degree programme in Dentistry.

For degree programmes in Cardiocirculatory and Cardiovascular Perfusion techniques, Physiotherapy, Speech therapy, Orthoptic and ophthalmologic assistance, Childhood neuro and psychomotricity, Dietistic, Imaging and radiotherapy techniques, Biomedical laboratory techniques, Environment and workplace prevention techniques:

- A.** integrated degree programme qualification in one of the Health Professions degree courses obtained at Università Cattolica;
- B.** enrolment in the second or third year in one of the Health Professions degree courses.

Duration of the assignment

1° September 2026 - 31 August 2027

Commitment

Up to a maximum of 350 hours; the number of hours may vary depending on the number of students assigned.



Typology of activity

Welcoming incoming new students for undergraduate, graduate and integrated degree programmes; support during the university course (planning exams, organizing study, identifying an effective study method), intercepting students in difficulty, planning recovery activities and collaborating on orientation initiatives.

The activities must be guaranteed according to the indications provided by the tutoring office, in relation to the specific needs of individual degree programmes.

Training

Group Tutors must compulsorily participate in the initial training activity scheduled starting from 1° September 2026. The training will be delivered exclusively in Italian.

Remuneration

21 Euro/hour gross of withholding taxes.

Forms and submission application

Selection

A selection committee, appointed by the Faculty Council, will analyse the applications received and make an initial selection with the aim of ensuring that the candidates are representative of the various degree programmes and in the light of the following criteria:

- *curriculum studiorum* (qualification obtained, grade, study plan, profile if applicable, possible enrolment in PhD programme);
- *curriculum vitae*.

Only pre-selected candidates will undergo an aptitude and motivational interview, to be held by the end of June 2023.

The final ranking will be drawn up based on the following points:

- up to a maximum of 40 points out of 100 for CV and CS
- up to a maximum of 60 points out of 100 for the interview

The list of successful candidates and the assignment of tasks will be communicated by e-mail. The minutes of the selection will be available in the Tutoring office.

In the event of inability or failure to perform the required tasks, the Group Tutor will be declared disqualified.

Pursuant to articles 13 and 14 of the European Regulation 2016/679 on "protection of persons individuals with with regard the processing of personal data" ('GDPR'), the data provided by candidates will be collected at the Orientation and Tutoring office of Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore - Largo Francesco Vito, 1 - 00168 Rome and processed for the purpose of managing the selection procedure and the possible contractualization process (information on processing available at: <https://www.unicatt.it/privacy.html>).
