**SCHOLARSHIP  
'INVERNIZZI FOUNDATION'  
ACADEMIC YEAR 2022/2023**

A scholarship worth € 9,624.00 is established for the following graduate programme of the Faculty of Agriculture, Food and Environmental Sciences of the Cremona campus of Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore:

*- Agricultural and Food Economics*

reserved for deserving and needy students enrolled in the first year of the above-mentioned degree programme for the academic year 2022/2023.

To participate, it is necessary to have obtained an undergraduate degree with a mark of no less than 108/110, foreign students must hold an equivalent foreign degree, and have an "equivalent" income (as determined by the "General regulations for determining university fees - academic year 2022/2023 - Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore") of no more than € 50,000.00.

The winner of this call for applications must have acquired, by 31 October 2023, 36 ECTS with an average mark of no less than 26/30 in order to be eligible for the scholarship in the second year of the degree programme.

Students wishing to apply for the scholarship must submit the following documents on plain paper:

- application for participation in the call addressed to the Rector of Università Cattolica. The application must include personal details, date and place of birth, domicile, telephone number, e-mail address and tax code (attached);
- self-certification attesting graduation (degree programme, grade and date of graduation);
- self-certification of enrolment in the first year of the above-mentioned degree programme in the academic year 2022/23;
- motivation letter, as per the attached facsimile;
- curriculum vitae.

The documentation must reach the **Direzione di sede - Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore - Via E. Parmense 84 - 29122 Piacenza - email: [direzione.sede-pc@unicatt.it](mailto:direzione.sede-pc@unicatt.it) - by 31 March 2023.**

The allocation of scholarships will be made at the sole discretion of the special Committee appointed by the Rector on the basis of merit criteria and household income. In the event of equal merit, the lower income prevails.

**The scholarship is incompatible with other grants or scholarships received by the student in the same academic year, including the scholarship provided by EDUCatt.**

**Please note that it is possible to apply for both the present call and the EDUCatt scholarship call. However, applications from students who, as of 31 December 2022, have been found ELIGIBLE in the EDUCatt ranking list will not be considered.**

**Tax treatment of scholarships:** the scholarships awarded are subject, for tax purposes, to the regulations in force on scholarships. **The sum paid is income assimilated to employment and therefore has the same tax treatment.**
