## Two intakes: Fall/September and Spring/January

- Work with the Cattolica Intl Education Office for the nomination process
- Online application: <http://apply.wisconsin.edu>
  - Apply as a special/non-degree-seeking student
  - Exchange students do **NOT** pay an application fee.
- University transcript with English translation & current courses.
- Course Selection Form
- Passport copy
- UWL Background Information form
- English proficiency: 73 TOEFL , 6.0 IELTS, 54 PTE
- -Academic, or 100 Duolingo English Test
- **SAT is not required**
- Proof of Funding – Affidavit of Support

# Important Steps After Acceptance

- Apply for on-campus housing (required for new exchange students)
- Take placement exams in mathematics and English (required to pre-enroll new freshmen in classes)
- Submit the UWL Affidavit of Support and bank statements so we can issue the I-20 immigration document
- Apply for the F-1 student visa and pay the I-901 SEVIS fee
- Attend the virtual “Visa Preparation and Pre-Departure Planning” session hosted by UW-La Crosse
- Submit the “Arrival Form” after they have received their visa and made their travel arrangements
